December's LDPOA Board Meeting will be held on the second Saturday, December 10.

FINDING WHAT YOU NEED?

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Could there be a P&E Trail (Easement) on MY property? ... and what does that mean to me?

What Is a P&E Trail?

A "Pedestrian & Equestrian Trail" or easement is a public access easement and there are over one hundred miles of dedicated P&E trails networking throughout the Lake Don Pedro subdivision which makes our subdivision one of the last open areas to offer beauty, wildlife, and opportunity to hike or ride out our back door.

How wide are they? What authority governs them?

The "Pedestrian & Equestrian Trail" easements are 30-foot-wide public access easements that were dedicated and established for public use through many of the lots as the subdivision developed. They are reflected in the preliminary title reports for property buyers, and are enforced by county ordinances.

So what's the problem?

These trails are still in existence but more and more riders and hikers are finding that homeowners may have forgotten that these dedicated easements still exist and have planted, built or placed objects that encroach, obstruct, or carelessly litter our beautiful trails.

Mariposa County Ordinance 12.24.020 and Tuolumne County Ordinance #2117 both forbid obstructs to the easements. These ordinances were developed by the counties and are enforced by the counties

The Lake Don Pedro Owners Association wants to make sure all that property owners are aware of these easements and provide guidelines to ensure they are made available for use by the public.

How do I avoid violations?

If you have any questions about easements on your property, check your preliminary title report or contact the LDP Owner's Assoc. office (209 852-2312) for information.

If you make any exterior building or grading improvements to your property,



you must submit the proper paperwork to the Owners Association, Architectural Compliance Committee for review. Contact our office for the process to begin your project.

This is in addition to any county building or grading permits that might be required for your project.

These steps help to ensure that public and utility easements are protected. We also have CC&R's to follow within the subdivision as well.

Is there any help available for the maintenance or clearing of a P&E easement?

The Lake Don Pedro Trailblazers are a group of volunteers who are committed to seeing a positive change in our community parks and trail system by offering free help as a service to landowners.

If you need help clearing the easements on your property, they will come and help you remove, tear down, or clean up the trail easement located on your property.

Sometimes, jobs that seem overwhelming really are small when a group tackles the job. Please, call if you need help or if you are interested in becoming a volunteer to aid in improving the outdoor experience in our beautiful area - 852-9459.
